

ORDINANCE NO. 18

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF NEVIS ORDINANCE NO. 18
PROHIBITING PARKING FOR THE PURPOSE OF SNOW REMOVAL.**

The City Council of the City of Nevis ordains as follows:

Section 1. On any day when snow accumulation is 2 inches or more no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on all city streets between the hours of two o'clock A.M. and eight o'clock A.M.

Section 2. Exceptions – Police cars, hearses, ambulances, and fire department vehicles responding to an emergency call. Vehicles called out for emergency repairs to electric light and power lines, telephone lines and water systems.

Section 3. The police department of this city is hereby authorized to remove such vehicles from the street and to store the same for the owner thereof, such removal and storage charge to be paid by the owner of such vehicle.

Section 4. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty and no/100ths dollars (\$50.00), or in default thereof shall be imprisoned in the county jail for not to exceed thirty days together with the costs of prosecution in any case.

Section 5. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
