

NEVIS CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING

CALL TO ORDER: The Special Meeting of the Nevis City Council was called to order at 6:00p.m. by Mayor Jeanne Thompson.

Pledge of Allegiance

ROLL CALL: Council Members: Blair Reuther, Teresa Leshovsky and John Carrier, City Administrator: Dawn Veit and Fire Chief: Josh Winter.

TOPIC OF DISCUSSION:

1. Fire Department Vehicle.

Josh Winter brought to the council a quote for a new pickup for the fire department. Along with the quote for the truck, he had the spec sheets for the equipment that would be added to the truck to make it a "first responder" vehicle.

Quote for pickup from Nelson Auto Center:	\$43,651.80
Quote for Iconic Metalgear Insert:	\$16,687.27
<u>Quote for Code 4 Services:</u>	<u>\$ 9,722.93</u>
TOTAL PACKAGE:	\$70,062.00

(The Nevis Fire Relief Association donated \$90,000.00 to the city Fire Department general fund in 2022 for purchases such as this. Therefore, no monies will be used from the Levy Budgeted amounts.)

Josh did contact different car dealerships and Nelson Auto Center gave the city the best deal on a purchase price. The chief also mentioned that it would take a few thousand dollars to get the vehicle lettered with the department logos.

Our current First Response Vehicle will be put up for bids once the new vehicle has arrived. Josh states that he will start the bidding process at \$10,000.00. The city will accept silent bids until a certain date and then open these closed bids during an open city council meeting.

Motion by Blair, second by Teresa, and all unanimously approved spending up to \$75,000.00 for the pickup, insert, code 4 services and lettering of the new First Response Vehicle.
